Team Finals is a separate session from the regular age group State Championships. At the conclusion of the final regular age group session, team scores are totaled using the top four scores at Level 4 from each event. Teams that finish in $1^{\text {st }}$ through $8^{\text {th }}$ place will compete again, with scores starting from zero, in the Team Finals. Teams that finish in $9^{\text {th }}$ place or higher will receive their team awards per USA Gymnastics guidelines immediately following the final regular age group session.

There will be a coaches meeting at a time designated by the Host Club in which a representative from each of the pre-qualifying $1^{\text {st }}$ through $8^{\text {th }}$ place teams must be present or that team will be disqualified allowing the $9^{\text {th }}$ place team to compete. A club check, made payable to the host team in the amount of $\$ 100.00$ or $\$ 100.00$ in cash will be given to the meet director and a rotation order will be drawn based on the team scores after the last regular Level 4 age group session. Personal checks will not be accepted. The $9^{\text {th }}$ place team should be prepared to compete in the event should one of the top 8 prequalifying teams decide not to enter or if it is disqualified from Team Finals.

If your team makes Team Finals, you are then able to choose 6 gymnasts to compete on each event. They do not have to be the same gymnast for each event. The top four scores will count toward the team finals total score. No individual awards are given in this session. It is strictly a team event.

At the completion of the final regular Level 4 age group session, the gym will be cleared of all spectators, coaches and gymnasts. Spectator seating will be assigned for each team by the Meet Director. There must be a two hour rest break from the completion of the last preliminary session before stretch may begin for team finals. Doors will reopen 15 minutes prior to general stretch. An additional entry fee will be charged to all spectators.

At the completion of the Team Finals, team awards, based on the outcome of the Team Finals competition, will be presented.

## Competition Format Rules:

Judging panels will rotate to different events from prior sessions at the direction of the SJD. This change will not be announced until the start of Team Finals.

No score inquiries are permitted.
Non-competing gymnasts will be seated in a location designated by the Meet Director and will NOT rotate with their team.

Capitol Cup Format

- General Stretch: 20 minutes
- At the conclusion of General Stretch, all teams will individually march in to their first competitive event and prepare for timed warm-ups.
- Timed Warm Up: 6 minutes for each event per team on the main clock
- Team 1 will always warm up and compete first on each event
- Warm ups will begin and end at the call of the announcer only
- You may warm up 7 gymnast per team but only 6 will be allowed to compete
- Competition will rotate 1-2-2-1-1-2-2-1
