COVID-19 POLICIES

Maximum # of gymnasts: 150

Spectator Seating: Seating provided. Spectators may also bring their own chairs.

Mask Requirements: Spectators and coaches must wear masks at all times.
Gymnasts may wear a mask if they choose.

COVID-19 check procedures & waiver: temperature checks will be performed at the door. All spectators and coaches must sign a waiver.

Cleaning Protocol: All equipment will be cleaned in between sessions.

Judges: One judge panels, single occupancy rooms, judges hospitality includes boxed meals and per diem for meals not provided.

Coaches hospitality: Boxed meals will be provided.

Chalk: Chalk for gymnasts will not be provided. Individual chalk will be available for purchase.

Hand sanitizer will be available at each event and admissions.

Outside food is prohibited: Bottled drinks and box meals will be available for purchase.

Water fountains: available ONLY to refill water bottles.

Awards: Awards will be given immediately following each session in the last area of competition.
