**Registration:** The qualifying score is 35.00 for All Around athletes and 9.00 for IES athletes at the Xcel Platinum and Diamond levels. All registrations must be made through MeetMaker.com. Online payment is required at the time of registration. Please note that MeetMaker charges a 3% transaction fee for credit card payments– there are no additional charges for payments made via ACH from a checking account. A \$25.00 per gymnast late fee will be added through MeetMaker for registrations completed after April 5, 2021.

**Meet Format**: Modified Capitol Cup– 1 Gym with 2 sets of identical equipment with 1 floor. Flight A competes on one set of equipment, Flight B on the other. Timed warm-ups per level of gymnast will occur prior to competition– there will be no 30 second touch.

**Awards:** Individual event and All-Around awards will be presented to each age group at the conclusion of the competition– 40% in each age group. <u>There will be no team competition in 2021.</u> Senior Ceremonies will be conducted at the beginning of award sessions as necessary.

**Competition Schedule:** Final session times will be emailed to addresses used to register athletes in MeetMaker as well as posted to pagymnastics.com, meetmaker.com and centreelitegymnastics.com.

**Coaches Information:** All coaches planning on coaching during the competition MUST be registered through USA Gymnastics Reservation System for membership verification. Coaches must present their current USAG Professional Member card at sign in. Any coach not registered will be unable to coach until membership verification has been completed.

## Povid 19 Policies and Procedures

### ENTRY TO COMPETITION FACILITY:

- There will be separate entry points for athletes/ coaches & spectators. You will only be allowed to enter the facility through these entry points.
- Doors will open for entry to the facility no more than 30 minutes before gymnast check in so that the competition floor may be cleared out and sanitized.
- Spacing and distancing of lines will be required before entry. You may be asked to wait outside prior to entering the facility to assist with social distancing.
- <u>Athletes/ Coaches & Spectators will enter through separate doors at the front of the building</u>. Masks will be required upon entry.
- All persons (athletes, coaches, judges, spectators etc.) entering the facility will be temperature checked and asked to utilize hand sanitizer upon entrance to the building. Temperatures exceeding 100.3 or persons showing flu-like symptoms will NOT be permitted entrance into the facility.
- Spectators are asked to have exact change or provide credit card for spectator entry fees.

### SPECTATORS:

- Only <u>2 spectators</u> per athlete will be allowed to attend the competition. Spectators may be required to name their athlete upon entry to ensure spectator limits are maintained.
- All spectators will be required to wear masks while inside the facility.
- Spectator seating will be spaced to allow for social distancing. Spectators will be asked to refrain from moving seats during the competition. Chairs will be available in groupings for family members.

### **VOLUNTEERS:**

- Volunteers must be temperature screened prior to entering the facility for their working session.
- Volunteers will be required to wear masks while working.
- Volunteers will be asked to remain at their assigned station until the completion of the competition.
- Volunteers and coaches will be asked to refrain from sitting at judging tables while judges are on break and between events/ sessions.

### COACHES & JUDGES:

- Areas will be provided for coaches and judges that allow for social distancing during breaks. These locations will be cleaned and sanitized between use.
- Coaches will be asked to refrain from sitting at judges tables while judges are on break and between events/sessions.
- Coaches and athletes should do their best to maintain 6' distancing whenever possible.
- Coaches will be asked to wear masks but can remove them when spotting if needed.

#### GYMNASTS:

- Gymnasts will be required to wear masks when entering facility and until they arrive at their specified station on the competition floor. Masks will be required when leaving the competition floor for any reason. Gymnasts will be asked to wear masks when not actively participating in warm ups or competition.
- Gymnasts will be asked use hand sanitizer before and after each event. Sanitizer will be available at each event for the gymnasts and coaches.
- Gymnasts must provide their own personal water bottle and bottle must remain in their bag when not being used- drinking fountains will not be available.
- Gymnasts must provide their own chalk bag/ box, spray bottles, brushes etc. Coaches may receive a block chalk at each session as needed but there will be NO common chalk bowls.
- Gymnasts bags must be carried from event to event and left in the specified bag stations during competition.
- \*\*Centre Elite Gymnastics follows all PA State and CDC COVID-19 Health and Safety recommendations for safety and cleanliness. It is our goal to provide a safe and enjoyable competition for all athletes, coaches, judges, spectators and volunteers. ## Povid 19 Policies and Procedures

#### **COMPETITION FLOOR:**

- Session numbers will be limited to no more than 64 athletes to allow for social distancing of athletes, coaches, judges and volunteers.
- Athletes will be asked to wash hands/ use hand sanitizer before and after competition.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at each event for all participants to utilize.
- Gymnasts and coaches will report to their first event for competition announcements and the playing of the National Anthem.
- Teams will be asked to skip presentation to the judges before events- athletes will present before competition routines only.
- Equipment, matting and judges tables will be cleaned and sanitized between sessions.
- Spectator seating will be cleaned and sanitized between sessions.
- Gymnasts and coaches will be asked to refrain from high fives, handshakes, hugs etc. Fist bumps and elbow bumps will be suggested.
- At the conclusion of the competition, athletes and coaches will be dismissed to the awards area, then spectators will be dismissed.

#### AWARDS:

- Awards will be conducted in a separate area from the competition floor. Clubs will be asked to maintain distancing while awaiting awards.
- Individual medals will be handed out following the conclusion of the competition.
- Athletes will be required to wear masks during the award ceremonies and will be asked to remain seated unless called to the podium.
- Athletes will be called for placement awards. Podium spots will be 6 feet apart to ensure distancing.
- Senior recognition ceremonies will be held at the beginning of the award session as necessary.
- All athletes, coaches and spectators will exit the facility from the awards area.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

- Water fountains will not be available during the competition. Athletes should bring personal water bottles.
- Bathroom facilities will be monitored and cleaned every hour. Lines for restrooms need to maintain social distancing. The number of persons permitted in the restrooms will be limited to 4 people at any given time.
- Separate entrance and exit points will be utilized during the competition. Hand sanitizer will be available at entrance and exit points.
- Concessions will be available during the competition. Spectators are asked to consume all food and beverages in the concession seating area and not in the spectator seating areas.
- All spectators will be respectful of all athletes, coaches, judges, volunteers and other spectators and will be asked to promote a positive and encouraging atmosphere. Spectators who do not comply with these expectations may be asked to leave.
