

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Where is the closest airport to fly into?

A: St. Louis

Q: Can gymnasts stay offsite with their parents or do they need to stay in the dorms?

A: Gymnasts are not required to stay overnight at the dorms. Lodging and meals are optional.

Q: Can coaches stay at the dorms too?

A: Yes, it is a \$35/night fee for room and board
